Future Steps


 Survey will continue to distribute among students through the next school year through online

SURVEY RESULTS

- 87 total results
- Over half of the responses stated that students felt safe throughout the school year
- However, there is 33% percent that feel uncertain

87 responses






SURVEY RESULTS CONT.

- Students pointed out that having an adult would enhance their safety
- Within the short answer response, not many students replied since it was optional but about 3 students did submit
 - o "Don't interfere with teens problems because we all know an adult who won't talk it out because that doesn't do anything but we have an adult who takes action."

85 responses




SURVEY RESULTS CONT. 2
